# **DESCRIPTION**

Under general supervision by the Pool Manager and Recreation Supervisor, provide swim lessons/ private or group to all ages, levels and abilities.

- 1. Maintain the safety of participants in and around the class.
- 2. Provide instruction for varying ages and abilities.
- 3. Work with other instructors in co teaching certain classes.
- 4. Educate participants on proper technique and promote swimmer safety.
- 5. Submits completed report cards, lesson plans, and attendance sheets information on time.
- 6. Maintain a clean facility performing house cleaning duties.
- 7. Attends mandatory in-service trainings weekly to develop teacher development.
- 8. Communicate effectively with the lifeguards on duty and act as a team in an emergency.
- 9. Deliver excellent customer service to all that utilize the facility.
- 10. Complete additional duties as assigned.
