**SUBJECT: APPROVAL OF RESOLUTION 26-06-765, A RESOLUTION CALLING THE GENERAL DISTRICT ELECTION TO BE CONSOLIDATED WITH THE GENERAL ELECTION ON NOVEMBER 3, 2026**

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## **RECOMMENDATION**

Approve Resolution 26-06-765, a Resolution calling the General District Election to be consolidated with the General Election on November 3, 2026.

## **BACKGROUND**

The District is required to instruct the County of Sacramento Voter Registration and Elections Office when the District desires to be consolidated with the General Election and to specify details such as the date of the election, the number and type of vacancies, the number of words in the candidates statement, statement costs responsibilities, procedures in case of a tie vote, and certification of District boundaries. A resolution is required.

In addition to the resolution, the District must submit three (3) associated documents to the County of Sacramento: the Notice of District Election, the Publication of Notice of Election, and the Map and Boundary Certification.

**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE  
ORANGEVALE RECREATION & PARK DISTRICT CALLING THE  
GENERAL DISTRICT ELECTION TO BE CONSOLIDATED WITH  
THE GENERAL ELECTION**

**WHEREAS**, an election will be held within the Orangevale Recreation & Park District on Tuesday, November 3, 2026, in Sacramento County for the purpose of electing two Directors, each for a full term of four years, to be elected **At Large**; and

**WHEREAS**, a General Election will be held within the County of Sacramento on the same day; and

**WHEREAS**, Elections Code §10403 requires jurisdictions to file with the Board of Supervisors, and a copy with the Registrar of Voters, a resolution requesting consolidation with a statewide election; and

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Orangevale Recreation & Park District requests the Board of Supervisors of Sacramento County to consolidate the regularly scheduled Presidential General Election; and

**NOMINATION OF CANDIDATES FOR THE GOVERNING BODY**  
Said election shall be to fill a vacancy for the following Board Members who resigned and/or whose terms expired.

Said Board Members for this District are elected in the following manner: **At Large** There are no divisions in the district, all voters in the district vote for all candidates.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that publication of candidate's statement, pursuant to Election Code §13307(a) the limitation on the number of words that a candidate may use in their candidate's statement shall not exceed 200 words; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the cost of the Candidate Statement shall be paid by the candidate at the Sacramento County Voter Registration and Elections Department; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that in the case of a tie vote, the election shall be determined by **LOT**. Elections Code §10551(b); and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the District hereby certifies that there **NO** District Boundary changes since our last election; and

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**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Orangevale Recreation and Park District agrees to reimburse the Registrar of Voters for actual costs accrued, such costs to be calculated by the method set forth in the County's current Election Fee Schedule; and

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Orangevale Recreation & Park District request the Board of Supervisors of the Sacramento County consolidate the regularly scheduled General District Election with the Presidential General Election to be held on November 3, 2026:

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**NOTICE OF DISTRICT ELECTION**  
**Orangevale Recreation & Park District**

Notice is hereby given that a General District Election will be held on November 3, 2026, in this District. The offices for which candidates may declare their candidacy are:

- District Director (Full Term – 4 years): Two (2) Openings

Qualifications: Each candidate must meet the following qualifications for office as specified in the principal act or code under which this district is organized: Government Code, Sections 56261.1 and 56439(c).

- Be a registered voter of the District
- Reside in the District

Official declarations of candidacy for eligible candidates desiring to file for any of the elective offices may be obtained from the office of the Registrar of Voters at 7000 65th Street, Suite A, Sacramento, CA 95823-2537, on and after July 13, 2026, and must be filed no later than 5:00 p.m. on August 7, 2026. However, if a declaration of candidacy for an incumbent is not filed by August 7, 2026, any person other than the incumbent shall have until 5:00 p.m. on August 12, 2026, to file a declaration of candidacy for such office.

Appointment to each elective office will be made by the supervising authority as prescribed by Elections Code §10515 in the event there are no candidates or an insufficient number of candidates for such office and a petition for an election is not filed within the time prescribed by Elections Code §10515; that is, by 5:00 p.m. on August 7, 2026.
