

NOTICE UNDER THE AMERICANS WITH DISABILTIY ACT

FOR ORANGEVALE RECREATION & PARK DISTRICT

Nondiscrimination Notice:

In accordance with the requirements of title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 ("ADA"), Orangevale Recreation & Park District will not discriminate against qualified individuals with disabilities on the basis of disability in its services, programs, or activities.

Employment: Orangevale Recreation & Park District does not discriminate on the basis of disability in its hiring or employment practices and complies with all regulations promulgated by the U.S. Equal Employment Opportunity Commission under title I of the ADA.

Effective Communication: Orangevale Recreation & Park District will generally, upon request, provide appropriate aids and services leading to effective communication for qualified persons with disabilities so they can participate equally in Orangevale Recreation & Park District programs, services, and activities, including qualified sign language interpreters, documents in Braille, and other ways of making information and communications accessible to people who have speech, hearing, or vision impairments.

Modifications to Policies and Procedures: Orangevale Recreation & Park District will make all reasonable modifications to policies and programs to ensure that people with disabilities have an equal opportunity to enjoy all of its programs, services, and activities. For example, individuals with service animals are welcomed in Orangevale Recreation & Park District offices, even where pets are generally prohibited.

Anyone who requires an auxiliary aid or service for effective communication, or a modification of policies or procedures to participate in a program, service, or activity of Orangevale Recreation & Park District, should contact Jason Bain, ADA/Section 504 Coordinator, as soon as possible but no later than 48 hours before the scheduled event.

The ADA does not require Orangevale Recreation & Park District to take any action that would fundamentally alter the nature of its programs or services or impose an undue financial or administrative burden.

Complaints that a program, service, or activity of Orangevale Recreation & Park District is not accessible to persons with disabilities should be directed to:
